- **SJVNL to set up 50 MW Wind Farm Soon**
Satluj Jal Vidyut Nigam Ltd (SJVNL), is planning to invite bids in the upcoming few months for the proposal of its upcoming 50MW wind farm. The plant is expected to be commissioned in 2012, shortlisted Gujarat, Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan and Tamil Nadu for setting up the plant.
- **MTNL Plans to set up wind power plant in Maharashtra**
MTNL plans to diversify into wind power project in Maharashtra, and plans to hire consultants to carry out feasibility study over its proposed power plant. The expected cost of the project shall be around INR 100 crores.
- **Upcoming Development Projects in and around Mumbai**
A number of infrastructure projects are expected to come up in the Mumbai region. This includes development of Navi Mumbai International Airport and Integrated Passenger Water Transport.
- **Karnataka sanctions 114 Mw green energy projects**
Power-starved Karnataka has accorded sanction to 21 renewable energy projects for a combined generation capacity of 114 Mw of power. The state government recently issued an order for these projects. However, the projects are subject to clearances from the departments of water resources, forest, ecology, and pollution control board among others.
- **Delhi Mumbai Investment Corridor expected to come out with tenders soon.**
Delhi-Mumbai Industrial Corridor is a mega infra-structure project of USD 90 billion with the financial & technical aids from Japan, covering an overall length of 1483 KMs between the political capital and the business capital of India, i.e. Delhi and Mumbai.

- **Power ministry cuts capacity addition target 35%**
Slow project implementation by the central sector in 2010-11 has forced the ministry of power to reduce its capacity addition target for the 11th Plan by 35% to 51,000 mw. At the beginning of the Plan, the government had set a target of adding 78,000 mw, which the ministry revised down to 62,000 mw after a mid-term appraisal. Latest estimates mean a further downward revision. In 2011, the central sector missed its target by 40%, adding 4,280 mw, even as state sector utilities missed their target by 57%, adding 2,759 mw. The private sector fell short of its target by a lower margin - at 5,121 mw, its achievement was 25% lower than the target.
- **Mumbai may get more power suppliers**
The Maharashtra Electricity Regulatory Commission (MERC) may allow multiple power suppliers in suburban Mumbai, giving consumers more options to choose from. MERC plans to give consumers the choice to pick and choose power suppliers on the basis of their efficiency and low tariff like in the Telecom Sector.
- **Tata Power-led consortium to set up 236 MW hydro projects in Himachal.**
A consortium of Tata Power and Norwegian entity SN Power has bagged the 236 MW Dugar Hydro Electric Project in Himachal Pradesh. The financial details, however, have not been disclosed. The project would be developed through a Special Purpose Vehicle (SPV) formed and owned by the consortium. The Dugar Hydro Electric Project is in Chenab Valley, Himachal Pradesh. The run of the river project would mainly feed the Northern grid.
